## What's the Role of a Community Champion?

- Support the Covid vaccination programme – engaging with the community to dispel myths, identify concerns and provide information.
- Share health information with your community, your family and friends, local groups, parents, and carers.
- Talk to people about your role and encourage others to sign up to be a Community Champion.
- Attend regular online meetings to keep up to date with the latest information and guidance.
- Take part in promotional activities, such as events, giving out leaflets putting posters in shops, restaurants, pubs, notice boards or community spaces and sharing posts on social media.

As a Champion, you will be a key point of contact for community members. signposting to healthcare services and ways to help with issues they might be facing that make it harder to live well.
